Template Instructions with Clipping Masks

1. To place an image on the template, open your photo and drag onto the template using the move tool.
2. In the layers window, drag the photo layer directly above the layer with the black shape where you'd like the photo to go.
3. With the photo layer selected there are a couple different ways to create a clipping mask and get your photo 'clipped' into the box.

Shortcut Keys

PC: Control + Alt + G (CS2 or higher)

Mac: Option + Apple + G (CS2 or higher)

From the Program Menu

Layer>Create Clipping Mask

Layers Window

Right click on the photo layer and select 'create clipping mask'

When you create a clipping mask the photo will clip to the black layer, hiding any part of the photo that extends beyond the black box. When you've successfully clipped the layer you will see a little paperclip link in the layers pallet next to the thumbnail.

4. Free transform (Control + T) and hold shift to keep your proportions even and adjust the size so you like what you see.
5. Repeat for each black box there is to insert all of your photos. Viola!
